D/M: Alan Parson was shot during an exchange of gunfire with police

officers and is in custody being treated for gunshot wounds.

I, David Barnes, with the New Orleans Police Department, certify under oath based on the information outlined below, that there is probable cause to believe RICHARD SANSBURY on or about 06/17/2019 did commit:

- 1 Count of RS14:64--Armed Robbery (with a firearm)-- (FELONY)
- 2 Counts of 14:46.1--False Imprisonment; offender armed with a dangerous weapons--(FELONY)
- WC 3 Counts of 14:16-1 False Imprisonment; Offender Armod with a dangerous weapon-
- **Counts of RS14:30/RS14:27--First Degree Murder of a Police Officer/Attempt-- (FELONY)
- *Counts of RS14:30/RS14:27--First Degree Murder of a Police Officer/Attempt-- (FELONY)
- Counts of RS14:30/RS14:27--First Degree Murder of a Police Officer/Attempt-- (FELONY)

within this State and Parish at: and the jurisdiction of the 41ST Judicial District Court, contrary to the form of the statutes of the State of Louisiana in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the same, in that the following did occur:

On Monday, June 17, 2019, at approximately 6:06 AM two subjects, later identified as Alan Parson (B/M DOB 3/30/2001) and Richard Sansbury (B/M DOB 3/31/93), entered the CVS store at 4901 Prytania Street. One subject was attired in a gray hooded sweatshirt with a white shirt

protruding below the sweatshirt and black pants with multi-colored piping on the side of the legs (Sansbury), while the second subject was attired in a black hooded sweatshirt and gray colored pants (Parson). As Sansbury entered the store he removed a firearm from his waistband. Both subjects had their hoods pulled over their heads and were wearing blue nitrile medical gloves.

Immediately after entering the store, Sansbury relocated behind the counter and detained one of the known victims who was at the store's cash register, using zip-ties. Sansbury then led the victim to an area near the store's office, out of view of the cameras. At the same time, Parson relocated to the pharmacy area of the store, where he forced another known victim to the ground and secured the victim's feet using zip-ties. Sergeant Barnes noted Parson was also wearing blue nitrile medical gloves. After forcing the known victim down, Parson began to fill a large trash bag with several pill bottles which he was removing from the safe in the pharmacy area of the store.

After approximately two minutes, Sansbury relocated to the pharmacy area and assisted Parson in removing several of the medical supplies from the pharmacy safes. Sansbury also interacted with the known victim and secured the second victim's hands with zip-ties as well. The subjects, after filling the large trash back with medicine from the pharmacy safes, exited the pharmacy area and relocated towards the front of the store at approximately 6:11 AM.

Upon reaching the front of the store, the suspects were confronted by three known NOPD Officers, all attired in NOPD Class B uniforms, easily identifiable as NOPD officers. Officers pointed firearms at the subjects and gave them commands to surrender. The subjects then fled towards the rear of the store. The officers then retreated outside of the front door of the store, where the fully uniformed officers gave commands for Parson and Sansbury to surrender and

waited for the subjects to exit the store.

DULY OF CARBONS

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Parson and Sansbury relocated to the front of the store a second time and exchanged gunfire with the officers. During the exchange of fire, a known NOPD Officer was struck. Parson and Sansbury then exited the store, continuing to fire their weapons towards the officers as they did, and fled the location, running towards the river. During the exchange, both Parson and Sansbury were struck. As they fled, Parson collapsed in the 1300 block of Lyons Street where he was apprehended and transported to University Medical Center for Treatment. Sansbury continued to flee to the 4900 block of Coliseum Street where he was apprehended hiding in the curtilage or 1116 Upperline Street.

Based on the information contained in this application, Sergeant Barnes believes Alan Parson (B/M DOB 3/30/2001) and Richard Sansbury (B/M DOB 3/31/93) are in violation of Louisiana Revised Statutes Title 14:64, Relative to Armed Robbery (with the use of a dangerous weapon), two counts of 14:46.1, Relatives to False Imprisonment; offender armed with a dangerous weapons, and three counts of 14:27-30, relative to attempted first degree murder of a police officer.
